LOUISA FRANCES MEDLAND 1844-1873

Louisa was born in Cornwall but by 1851 she was living at the Vicarage, Brimpton, where her father Rev. Edward Golding was working. In 1863 she married Rev. William Medland in Hastings. They had five daughters, the last, Margaret, being born in Newbury.



In 1871 William, who was assistant priest at St John's Church (*left*), Newbury, died following an operation for cancer. He is

buried in Newtown Road Cemetery. He is included in the Angels, Artists and Authors tour as he wrote a book, 'Lame

Annie', of which there is a copy in the British Library.

Two years later Louisa, still at 5, Porchester Villas, succumbed to TB and died aged 29 on Boxing Day. She is buried next to William, near the Chapel.

Her daughters were cared for by relatives.
